## CURRICULAR PRACTICAL TRAINING APPLICATION INTERNSHIP CERTIFICATE PROGRAM

The regulations state that Curricular Practical Training must be "an integral part of an established curriculum." It includes <u>Internship/Externship</u> for credits, <u>Practicum</u>, <u>Alternate Work Study</u> and <u>Cooperative</u> Education, which is offered by sponsoring employers through cooperative agreement with the school.

**NOTE:** Upon review of the application, the DSO will update the student's SEVIS record to reflect the Curricular Practical Training authorization and print a new SEVIS Form I-20 to return to the student prior to the beginning of the employment.

#### CHARACTERISTICS OF CURRICULAR PRACTICAL TRAINING Student must be lawfully enrolled on a full-time basis for one academic year. Note: Exception exists for graduates students whose programs require immediate curricular training. Must be an integral part of an established curriculum in the student's field of study. Must be part-time (20 hours or less while school is in session); full-time (over 20 hours) during summer vacation or holidays. ✓ Must have an <u>employer's offer letter</u> that qualifies as Curricular Practical Training. Student must work only for the employer mentioned in the offer letter. ✓ Must receive written authorization for the Designated School Official before work begins. Must continue to maintain a full course of study in F-1 status during the employment period. Student must be in good academic standing.
